7 Days/6 Nights Monday-Sunday, June 13-19, 2016

This summer, join Mr. Whitener and five of your fellow high school students for an adventure in Florida. We will be taking donated items to Rafiki Foundation's headquarters in Eustis, Florida for transport to Africa.

Pack two suitcases: One for Rafiki, one for you. Each participant is asked to pack and bring to Florida a suitcase with school supplies, toiletries, textiles, games and toys for the orphans living at the Rafiki Christian village in Mzuzu, Malawi (where Mr. Whitener volunteered last summer.) We plan to conduct a school-wide supplies drive to fill the suitcases.

After delivering the items and touring Rafiki's headquarters, it's time for educational adventure at Disney World, Universal, and Kennedy Space Center.

- ★ Deliver donated items to the Rafiki Foundation's headquarters in Eustis, Florida. Tour campus to learn more about Rafiki's mission to live the Gospel serving orphans and widows in Africa
- ★ Disney World's EPCOT World Showcase featuring pavilions of Norway, China, Germany, Italy, Japan, Morocco, France, United Kingdom, and Canada. We then explore Future World, where the latest technological offerings are located. Through a combination of hands-on activities and fantastic attractions, we'll experience exhibits that focus on ocean life, the land and our environment, imagination, health, energy, communication, space exploration and transportation
- ★ Universal Studios Orlando & Islands of Adventure experiencing the Wizarding World of Harry Potter
- ★ Disney's Animal Kingdom. Ride "Expedition Everest - Legend of the Forbidden Mountain" and experience "Kilimanjaro Safaris"
- ★ NASA's Kennedy Space Center at Cape Canaveral on the Atlantic. NASA's launch headquarters traverses an amazing area that includes towering launch pads, rockets, and history-making technology. Visit the Rocket Garden and view ten-story high rockets from all eras of space exploration
- ★ Airboat ride through the Florida wetlands

Spending money should only be necessary for checked baggage, lunch, snacks, and any personal expenses..
